

GenCyber **Teachers** Camp 2019 at Oakland University



The camp will introduce cybersecurity concepts as well as resources and methods to facilitate integration of the cybersecurity material into the elementary, middle, and high school curricula or after-school activities.

Camp's highlights:

- The camp is **FREE OF CHARGE** to all accepted K-12 teachers.
- Participants do not need any prior background or experience in cybersecurity to attend.
- Participants will receive a flat-rate stipend of **\$500**.
- Participants will leave the camp with resources and tools to keep and use in the classroom.
- Each participant will design lesson plans and/or activities based on what would integrate best into their curricula or after-school activities.
- Participants will receive additional stipend of **\$100** for reporting back on the Teaching Workshop day to talk about their teaching experiences.
- Participants will receive a **certificate of accomplishment**.
- **Continuing Education Units (CEUs)** will be offered.
